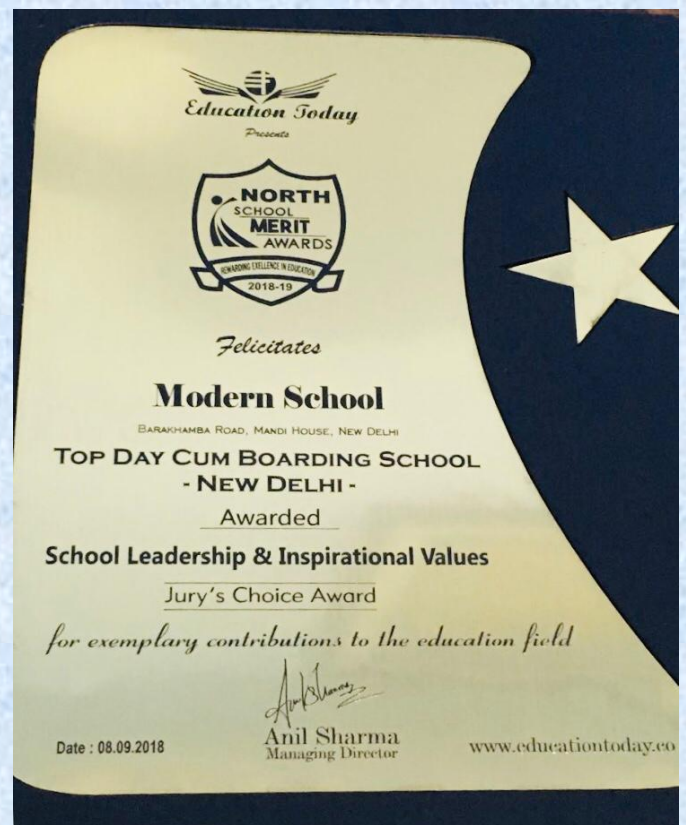
World 100 Educator Award
