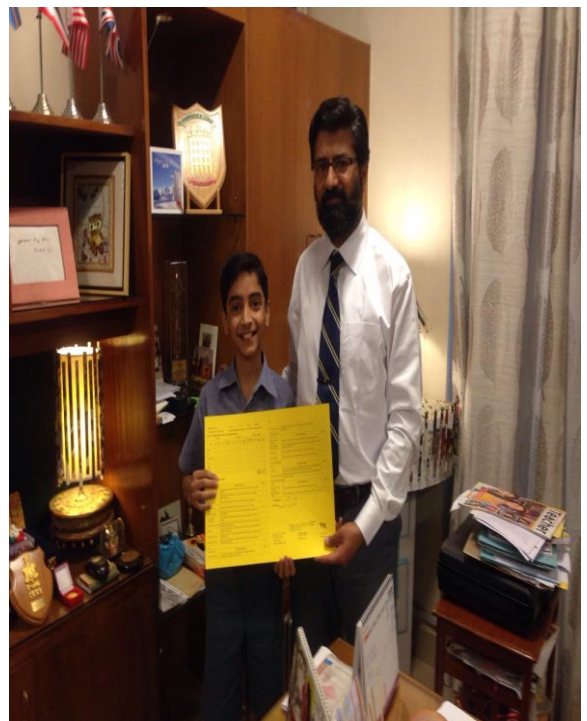
REVISION CLASSES FOR CLASS XI
