Follow the given instructions:

Materials required

- Orange Chart Paper (Half Sheet)
- ❖ Fevicol /Glue stick
- Scissors/ Staple pin
- **❖** Materials for decoration (Sketch pens/ Paints crayons etc.)

Step 1: Cut the orange chart paper into a square shape of approximately 17/17 inches.

Step 2: Turn it around so that it looks like a diamond.

Step 3: Cut a triangle with a base size of 9.5 inches and the other two sides of 6.5 inches. (From the remaining paper)

Step 4: Using a black paper draw images/objects related to tiger

Optional: add strips of paper at the bottom of the kite to make it flutter.
