Accolades for the Bizonomics Society at the Arthashastra and Confest, 2020

The Arthashastra and Confest, 2020, was an online commerce event organized by the Delhi Public School, Vasant Kunj on 1st and 2nd August 2020. A team of thirteen students of the Bizonomics Society from S6 and S7 represented the school at the competition. The fest comprised of seven different events challenging the students in areas of debating, business knowledge, and

stock market simulation, poster making and others. Modern School emerged victorious in two events amongst the top schools. Zaina Sharma(S6G) secured the Third place in an on-the-spot activity testing the business acumen of students. Rijul Ganju(S7E) and Arnav Mehra(S7E) bagged the Third position in the Stock Wars Event, a simulation of the real-life stock market. It was an immense learning experience for the participants.

Sewa Bharti, Delhi, works among the economically weaker sections of Indian society, including tribal and indigenous communities, urban slum dwellers and resettlement colonies (*Sewa Bastis*). The Sewa efforts aim at reinforcing four crucial dimensions of society: *Sewa* or Service, *Sanskar* or Values, *Samarasata* or Social Harmony and *Samriddhi* or Prosperity. Sewa Bharati organised a webinar titled “Teens 4 Sewa Workshop” on 8th August, 2020. The workshop aimed to familiarise students and mentors on the Teens Sewa Programme. The event commenced with students sharing their experience of the 'Each One Teach One' programme which was conducted in the past few months. The VHSMUN is one of the most prestigious Model UN conferences in India. The sixth edition of the VHSMUN'20, took place virtually from 14th-16th August 2020. The three days of intense debate saw over 500 extremely proficient delegates discussing the issues of global concern. The chief guest at the opening ceremony was Mr. Manish Tiwari, Honourable Member of Lok Sabha and a practicing lawyer in the Supreme Court. The chief guest at the closing ceremony was Admiral Lanba, PVSM, AVSM, ADC, India's 23rd Chief of Naval Staff and recipient of several honours such as Param Vishisht Seva Medal, Ati Vishisht Seva Medal and Samanya Seva Medal.

A delegation of thirteen students represented Modern School at the conference and displayed a combination of great knowledge and diplomacy. Eight delegates bagged awards from the delegation and received cash prizes.
