On 21st June 2020, the entire world experienced a wonderful Astronomical event - an Annular Solar Eclipse. Inspite of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, affecting the entire world the students of Modern School were able to participate in the "VIRTUAL ECLIPSE CHASE".

The Astronomy Club with the support of SPACE India ensured that all club members experience this phenomenal celestial event. Since the moon was at the furthest distance from earth, it covered only the central part of the sun and the edges of the sun were seen as a

ring around it. This eclipse is known as Ring of Fire Eclipse. The eclipse was beautifully visible from New Delhi for a duration of 3 hours 28 minutes. The students were advised not to see the eclipse with naked eyes and use safety solar glasses or see the reflection of the eclipse in a bucket of water.
