#### NOVUS INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

The Novus International Conference, 2021 was conducted by the City Montessori School, Indiranagar (Lucknow). It aimed to gauge the scientific aptitude of students from all over the world.

The Opening Ceremony of the competition was conducted on 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2021, where the host school displayed a variety of cultural performances. The Final Rounds to the events were conducted on 29<sup>th</sup> January, followed by the Closing Ceremony and prize distribution on 30<sup>th</sup> January, 2021. Modern School Barakhamba Road, participated in four events over the course of the competition.

Ishaan Singh(S1A), Ananya Bansal(S1G) and Angad Atharv Suri(S1F) represented Modern School in the RECAST event, wherein the participants were required to submit a short writeup or a sketch suggesting innovative features in technology.

Riyan Aggarwal(S3B) and Agrim Jain(S3B) secured the **First Consolation Prize** in this event for their project on the **'Purification of Air'**.

Modern School is proud of its students for putting up a stellar show at the international forum.






#### SANSKRIT ARTICLE WRITING


