WHAT'S NEW AT MODERN

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The RS Zoom Postcard meeting was hosted by the MLC School, Sydney on Wednesday, 10th March 2021. The meeting was a two -hour long online event that involved a discussion around the topic "Women of the World – Where do we stand?" The event brought together more than 100 students from 27 schools in Australia, Armenia, India, USA, Oman, South Africa, New Zealand, Tanzania, Germany, Pakistan, Japan, and UAE. Siddhant Ahuja (S6C) and Anirudh Jain (S6C) represented Modern School in the meeting. The event mainly comprised of two activities: the Changemakers activity and the Baraza discussion group activity.

The Changemakers activity explored the position of women in society and how women are taking on leadership roles.

The students discussed prominent changemakers (like Ruth Bader Ginsburg, Malala Yousafzai, and Emma Watson) and the advancements happening in their fields.

In the Baraza Discussion activity, the delegates were divided into smaller groups where they shared their own experiences on gender inequality and how the gender norms had impacted them. The event concluded with a final discussion on how the discussed changes can be brought about and how the students, as responsible citizens of this world, can contribute to make gender equality a reality.
