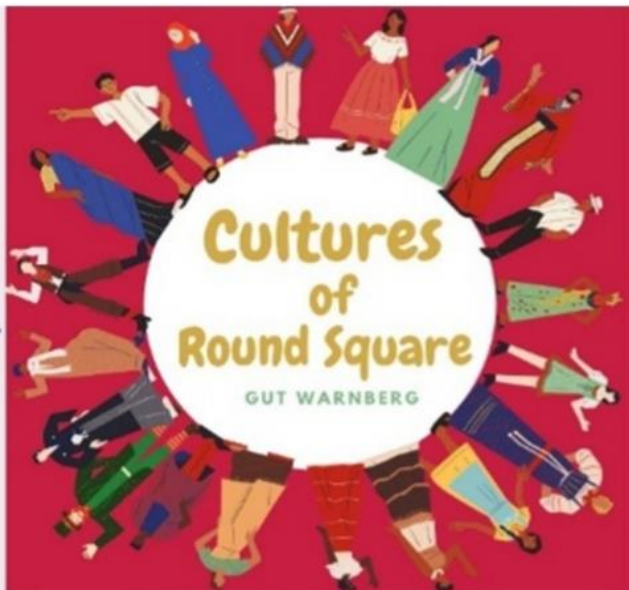

Cultures of Round Square

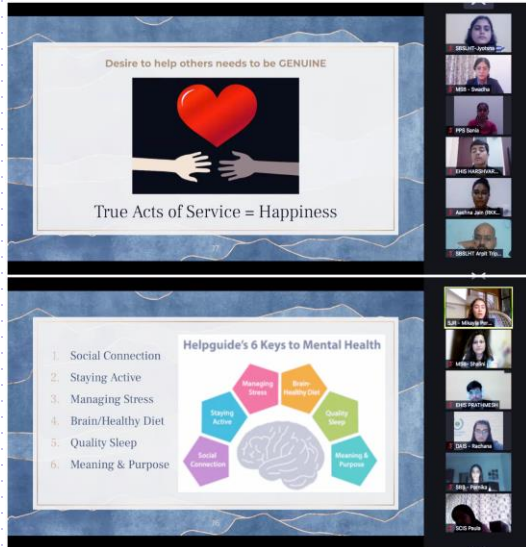

Optical Phenomenon - Halo Rainbow
