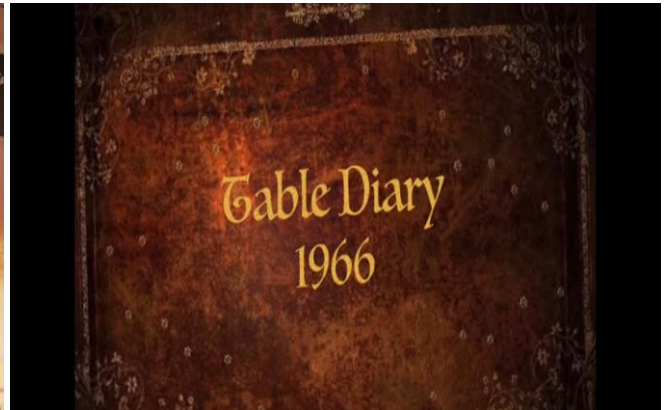
EXPRESSING CREATIVITY THROUGH REELS

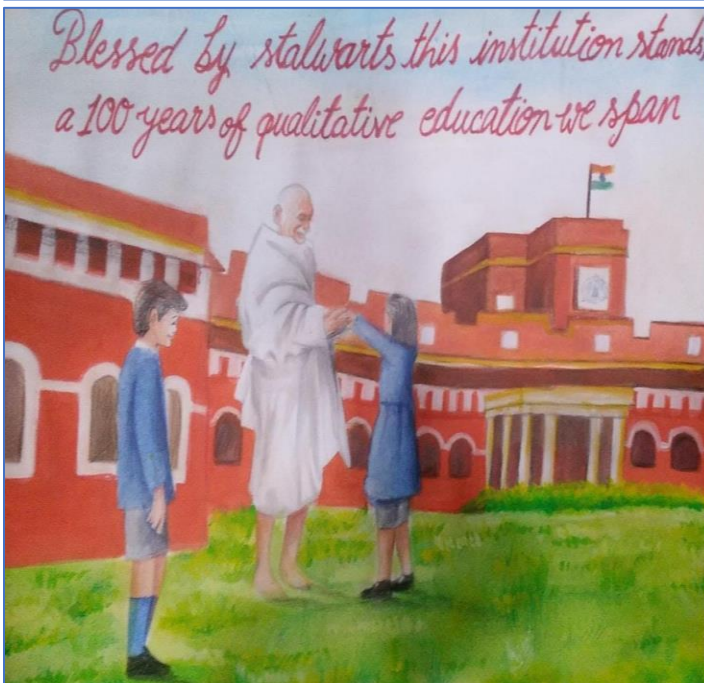

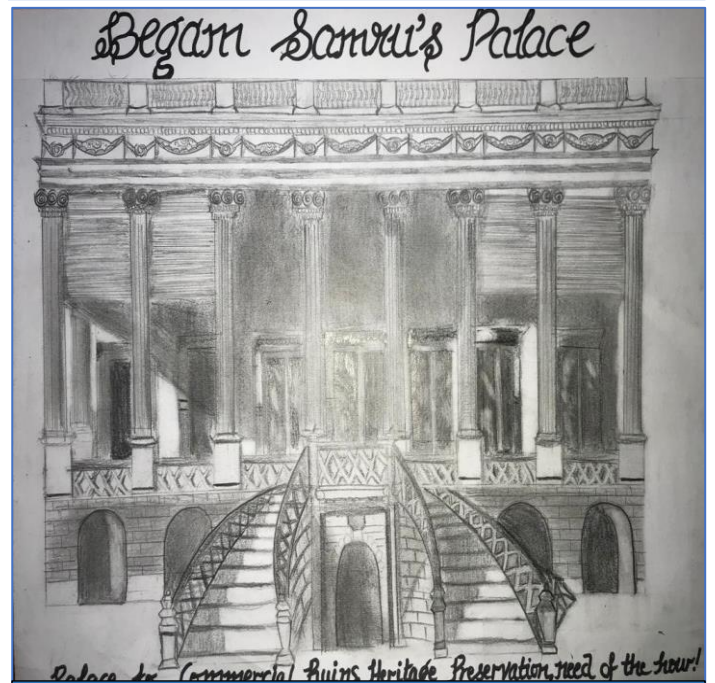
