MODERNITES BRING LAURELS IN SPORTS

With their soaring high spirits and commitment, the students of Modern School participated in the following sports tournaments:

- ❖ **5th Pradeep Virendra Singh Memorial Open Delhi State Ranking Championship** was conducted from 3rd June to 8th June 2022. **Kush Vats(S7H)** was declared the **Winner** in Mix Doubles U-19 Category. **Ryan Ranjan(S5C)** and **Apoorva Choudhary(S7J)** were Runner-Up in Boys Single U-17 and Girls Double U-17 Categories respectively.
- ❖ **45th Lala Raghbir Singh Hot Weather Cricket Tournament** was conducted from 20th May to 7th June 2022, in which twelve prestigious teams of the city competed. **Delhi Challengers Team** lifted the **Winner's Trophy** along with a cash prize of **Rs 2,50,000/-**. The Runner Up Trophy was bagged by **Players Academy** with a cash prize of **Rs 1,50,000/-**. Teams of **Rajnigandha Cricket Club** and Supporting C.C. were given **Rs 50,000/-** each for reaching Semi-finals. Distinguished dignitaries, the Principal, Dr Vijay Datta, Mr Pawan Gulati, the Treasurer DDCA, Mr Anil Chaudhary, an International Umpire were present for the prestigious event.
- ❖ In **Delhi State Level Swimming Championship** held at Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Complex from 17th to 19th June, 2022, Modernites emerged as champions and won a total of **20 medals**. **Tejasv P Arora(S7D)** and **Aditya Kumar(S7D)** won **Seven Medals** each in U-17 Category. **Dhruv Bakshi(S5E)** won a **Gold** and **Tanush Jhanji(S3H)** bagged a **Silver** and **two Bronze Medals** in U-14 Category. **Samraj Rathi(S1C)** won **two Bronze Medals** in U-12 Category.
- ❖ **4th Khelo India Youth Games** were held in Karnal (Haryana) from 5th to 9th June, 2022. **Tejasv Pratap(S7D)** participated in 400 m Free Style Swimming event representing Delhi State Team.

ALL INDIA POLITICAL PARTIES MEET: The committee was composed of eleven delegates from S5 representing leaders from six different political parties.
