School Information

- Modern School at Barakhamba Road is a co-educational high school which was established in 1920.It enrolls approximately 2500 students between grades 6-12, supported by a committed and qualified teaching faculty. The teacher-student ratio is 1:40. It is part residential, for outstation boys only.
- It has a junior branch, Raghubir Junior School at Humayun Road and a sister school at Vasant Vihar.
- The school academic year starts from April and closes in March. However, the class X and XII receive graduation certificates in the end of May. The term plan has been disrupted this year due to the pandemic.
- Medium of instructions is English from year 1-12.
- The school is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). The curriculum followed is the NCERT curriculum, inclusive of two National Level Examinations at class X and XII called the All India Secondary School Examination (AISSE) and All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE) respectively. Curricular and Examination Information

YEAR 6-10:

Subjects are studied at a Scholastic and Co Scholastic Level.

Scholastic Area: 5 subjects are taken of which two must be languages:

- 1. English: Compulsory for all.
- 2. Second language: Native/ foreign language.
- 3. Mathematics with laboratory work
- 4. Sciences with Laboratory Practical Physics, Chemistry, Biology.
- 5. Social Science History; Geography; Economics and Democratic Politics

Co-scholastic Area

The subjects studied are Computer Science and Applications, Socially Useful Productive Work (SUPW), Physical and Health Education and Co-Scholastic grades are given on it. From A-E on a 5 point scale Detailed syllabus for all subjects is at <u>www.cbse.nic.in.</u>

Examination Specifications

- The academic session is divided into two terms, April-October and November -March.
- In Year 11 and 12, each term has one unit test and assignments. This is followed by a Summative Test called Half Yearly and Annual Exam respectively.
- In addition to the school's internal assessment, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) conducts a nationwide examination for Class XII called the All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE)
- Additional Preboard examination in Year 12 are conducted before the Final Board examination
