School Information

- Modern School at Barakhamba Road is a co-educational high school which was established in 1920. It enrolls approximately 2500 students between grades 6-12, supported by a committed and qualified teaching faculty. The teacher-student ratio is 1:40. It is part residential, for outstation boys only.
- It has a junior branch, Raghbir Junior School at Humayun Road and a sister school at Vasant Vihar.
- The school academic year is from April - March. The National Board exams are in February and March.
- Usually, class X and XII receive graduation certificates in the third week of May. However last year the term plan was disrupted due to the Covid 19 pandemic and date of declaration of the result was 22 July 2022.
- The medium of instructions is English from year 1-12.
- The school is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). The curriculum followed is the NCERT curriculum, inclusive of two National Level Examinations, one at class X and next in XII called the All India Secondary School Examination (AISSE) and All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISCE) respectively. YEAR 6-10:

Subjects are studied at a Scholastic and Co Scholastic Level.

Scholastic Area: 5 subjects are taken of which two must be languages:

1. **English:** First Language is compulsory for all.
2. A regional/ foreign language.
3. Mathematics with laboratory work
4. Sciences with Laboratory Practical – Physics, Chemistry, Biology.
5. Social Science – History; Geography; Economics and Democratic Politics

Note – Hindi is additional & compulsory as the Second Language for all students in Grades 6-8

Co-scholastic Area

The subjects studied are Computer Science and Applications, Socially Useful Productive Work (SUPW), Physical and Health Education. Co-Scholastic grades on a 5-point scale, the range is from A-E

Covid Circumstances

During the academic year 2021-2022, teaching has been mostly online due to the Covid 19 pandemic and the government's directives. The year 11 Examination has been Online in Term I and Offline in Term II for the graduating class of 2023. However, they have had regular classes on campus since April 2022. Hence the academic session 2022-2023 i.e., the year 12 has been offline.

Information about the Graduating Class of 2023

Class size: The graduating class size in year XI was **376** and presently in class XII is **366**.

Subject streams: The entire cohort is divided into 3 streams: Science, Commerce and Humanities.
