The Purana Qila, also known as Qila-e-Kohna, is an ancient fort located in Delhi. It holds historical significance and has been a subject of archaeological excavations. Led by Dr. Vasant Swarnkar of the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI), the ASI has conducted excavations at the Purana Qila. On May 1, 2023, a group of class 10 students, accompanied by their teacher, Ms. Sonia Kapoor, visited the Purana Qila on a field trip. They were greeted by archaeologists who explained the artefacts and antiquities in great detail. The students learned about the transitional period and how different rocks and marbles were associated with specific dynasties. During their walk, the students encountered beautiful tombs and gardens within the Purana Qila.

They noticed similarities between these structures and other tombs constructed by the Mughals, reminiscent of Fatehpur Sikri in Agra. The students also visited a museum located within the fort, where they encountered detailed artefacts, paintings, sculptures, and architectural sites.

At the end of their excursion, the students felt a deep sense of appreciation for the rich history and cultural heritage that surrounded them.
