Indian Public School Conference Workshop on National Education Policy was held on 23rd April, 2023. It was attended by Modern School Principal Dr Vijay Datta, who is also the Director(Sports) IPSC. The workshop commenced with an enthralling session taken by Mr Anurag Tripathi, IRPS, Secretary, CBSE. He talked about the 21st century competencies like learning, communication, creativity, critical thinking, leadership and digital skills. He discussed about skill-based education and the administrative reforms initiated by the CBSE.

Four panels of speakers discussed the topics of Parental Alienation, Effects of Prolonged Custody Disputes on Children, Global Best Practices for Litigating Family Disputes and Mediation.
