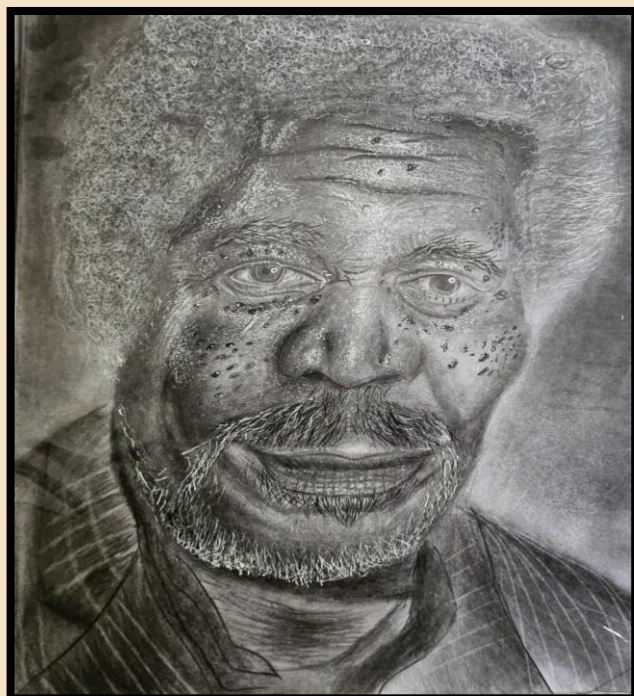

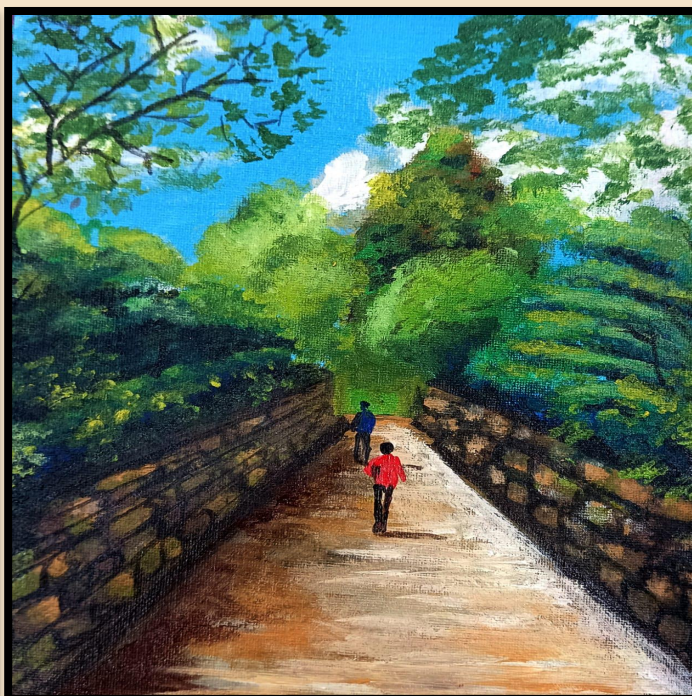
The event encouraged the students to be curious, informed and confident individuals. It was a resourceful and knowledge enriching experience for all the participants.



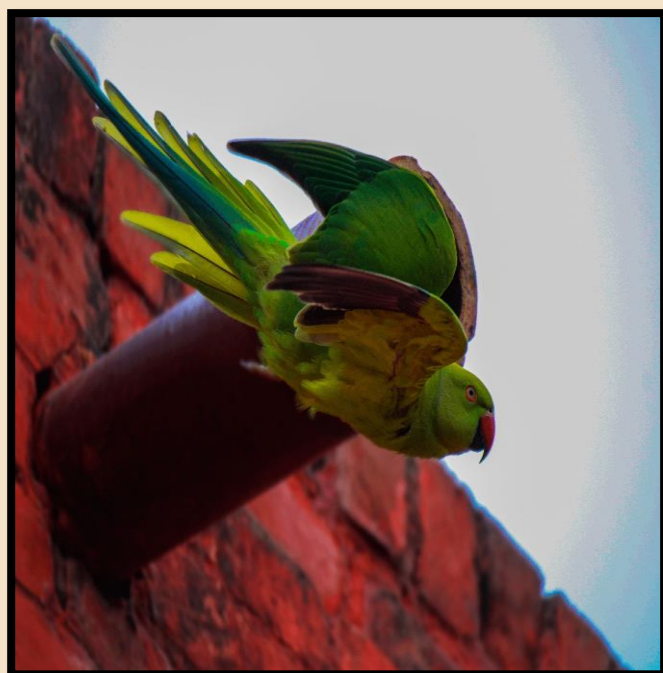
