## Riverdale Country School, USA Exchange Programme Fostering Global Friendship and Academic Success



From May 27<sup>th</sup> to June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024, eleven students from Modern School, Barakhamba Road participated in a prestigious ten days' exchange programme with Riverdale Country School in New York City. The programme aimed to foster cultural exchange, knowledge-sharing, and lifelong friendships between Riverdale Country School in the USA and Modern School, Barakhamba Road.

During their stay with the host families, the students immersed themselves in the local culture and everyday life. They attended classes at Riverdale, gaining an insight into the American educational system. The programme included a comprehensive tour of the Riverdale campus, highlighting its state-of-the-art facilities, and active participation in various subjects alongside their American counterparts.

The exchange programme was further enriched by an intensive study of the region's flora and fauna during a trip to the Bronx Zoo.
