About Modern School

- Modern School at Barakhamba Road is a co-educational high school which was established in 1920. It enrolls approximately 2500 students between Grades 6-12, supported by a committed and qualified teaching faculty. The teacher-student ratio is 1:40. It is part residential, for outstation boys and girls.
- It has a Junior School branch, Raghubir Singh Junior Modern School at Humayun Road, New Delhi from Pre- School (Nursery) up to Grade 5.
- The school academic cycle is from April to March.
- The medium of instruction is English from Grade 1-12.
- The school is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). The curriculum followed is the NCERT curriculum, inclusive of two National Level Examinations, one in grade X and next in grade XII called the All India Secondary School Examination (AISSE) and All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE) respectively. Grade 6-10:

Subjects are studied at a Scholastic and Co Scholastic Level.

Scholastic Area: Subjects studied are:

1. **English:** First Language is compulsory for all.
2. **Hindi** is additional and compulsory as the second Language (until Grade 8).
In Grade 9 & Grade 10, it's optional as 2nd language along with other regional / foreign language.
3. Mathematics with laboratory work.
4. Sciences with Laboratory Practical – Physics, Chemistry, Biology.
5. Social Science – History; Geography; Economics and Democratic Politics.
6. A regional/ foreign language (6th subject in Grade 6 to Grade 8 only).

Co-scholastic Area

The subjects studied are Artificial Intelligence (AI), Socially Useful Productive Work (SUPW), Physical and Health Education. Co-Scholastic grades are on a 5-point scale, the range is from A-E.

Examination specifications

- The academic session is divided into two terms, April-September, and October-March.
- Each term has one unit test and several assignments. Term 1 ends with Half Yearly Examination and Term 2 ends with Annual Examination.

3. Commerce Stream:

- Business Studies
- Economics
- Accountancy
- Mathematics/ Informatics Practices/Fashion Studies/ Physical Education/Home Science/Legal Studies/Painting

Co scholastic level: General Studies, Work Experience, Physical and Health Education.

Examination Specifications

- The academic session is divided into two terms, April-September, and October -March.
- Each term has one-unit test and assignments. Term 1 ends with Half Yearly Examination and Term 2 ends with Annual Examination.
- In Class XII Term 2 ends with a **Pre board Examination** held in December.

Class Ranks

The school does not provide ranks to students in their report cards. However, in university application portals such as the common app and UCAS, the following is reported for the eligible student:

- Top 5 ranks in each stream i.e. Science, Commerce and Humanities
- Top two deciles (Top 10% and Top 20%) of the whole class.

Information about the Graduating Class of 2025

Class size: The graduating class size in year XI was **384** and presently in class XII is **370**

Subject streams: The entire cohort is divided into 3 streams: Science, Commerce and Humanities.

Highest Marks: Highest marks achieved is calculated by taking the percentage of the total marks achieved in the five compulsory subjects.

Predicted scores: The predicted scores are calculated as a super score of the student's academic performance in Grade 11 and Grade 12 (up to Half Yearly Examination).
