## **OUTSTANDING BOARD RESULTS 2024-25**

The Board Results 2024-25 reflect an outstanding overall performance with a significant number of students achieving high marks

### **Class 12 Board Results (2024-2025) - Key Achievements**

**100% Pass Rate:** All 369 students passed the examination.

**121 students** scored **90% or above** (32.79% of total students).

**264 students** scored **80% or above** (71.54% of total students).

**345 students** scored **70% or above** (93.49% of total students).

#### **High Average Scores:**

Average percentage with Best 5 subjects (including English): **84.33%**.

Average percentage with Best 4 subjects: **86.59%**.

#### **Top Performers:**

**Raghav Singhal**, topped the School and stood first in the **Commerce Stream** with **98.80% marks** while Aditi Dotiya stood second with 98.40% marks.

**Tanay Jalan** was the highest scorer in **Science Stream** with **97.80% marks** while **Rhythm Mahajan** followed him with 96.80% marks.

**Jayatri Sharma Pathak** stood first in the **Humanities Stream** with **97.20% marks** whereas **Riana Singh** stood second with 95.80% marks.

**Raghav Singhal and Aditi Dotiya** are joint toppers in the best of four subjects with a score of **99.25%**.

**Thirty-six students** obtained a perfect score of **100 marks** in various subjects in Class 12 Examination.
